- **Cub Scouts** is a family centered program for boys aged 7 through 10 years old. This program revolves around family, educational & fun activities which are age appropriate. Exciting Summer Day & Resident Camp opportunities.
- **Boy Scouts** is a program for boys aged 11 through 17 years old. The aim is character development, citizenship and personal fitness. High Adventure Opportunities.
- **Venturing** is a relatively new, co-ed youth program for ages 14 through 20. The emphasis can be on exciting, high adventure outdoor activities or it can be focused on hobbies, youth groups, or a variety of other special interests. This program helps young people to pursue their special interests, develop leadership skills, and mature into productive adults.
- **Learning for Life** is a co-ed, Kindergarten through twelfth grade, in school, character development program. The aims of LFL is to teach young people how to properly conduct themselves in the real world.
- **Exploring** is a co-ed youth program for ages 14 through 20 years of age. Its aim is for young people to learn more about specific career fields. This is accomplished at different locations such as ambulance corps, hospitals, fire and police departments.
- 10 young men earned the prestigious Eagle Scout Award in 2015! Only around 4% of Boy Scouts ever reach this honorable goal.
- **Camp Gorton** located on Waneta Lake near Tyrone, NY and **Camp Brule** located in Sullivan County, PA. These two camps are of the utmost quality. The facilities and programs are second to none in the Northeastern part of the country! Camp Gorton sits on a Finger Lake and offers a wide variety of waterfront activities. Camp Brule is very rural and has a C.O.P.E. (Challenging Outdoor Personal Experience) Course, which highlights a climbing-repelling tower, a 300 foot long zip line along with several low elements to develop team work and self-confidence.
