First Aid Training designed to prepare you for many of the emergencies that may occur while on a Unit Campout or Trip, or even at a Unit meeting. The various trainings offered will cover a wide range of potential situations that you and your unit may face. The trainings will be conducted by an ECSI Certified Trainer. **You must be at least 14 years of age to attend.**

WHAT ELSE IS INCLUDED?

The certifications which will be earned upon the completion of this weekend include:

- ✧ Wilderness First Aid (2 year certification)
- ✧ Adult CPR with Automated External Defibrillator (AED) (2 year certification)
- ✧ Epi-Pen (2 year Certification)
- ✧ Asthma Inhaler (2 year Certification)
