

**Thunderbird “Thunder in the Hills:
Outlaw Pinewood Derby” FALL CAMPOREE

Thunder in the Hills is open to all registered members of the BSA. This includes Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Venturing, leaders, and parents of Cub Scouts. This campout is a “bring your own food, it will not be provided” kind of a campout. You will be permitted to have an above ground fire pit (must have legs on it, it cannot sit on or in the ground), firewood will be provided.

The fun starts on Friday, September 28, at 5:00 p.m. Come and set up your campsite, have dinner (if you haven’t already eaten) and get ready for the Friday night activity. Weather permitting it will either be a movie night or candy bar bingo!

On Saturday, after breakfast, we will be having activities for all. You can play volleyball and corn hole, sack races/3-legged races, and others games in the works. Or work on your outlaw car (leaders and parents, don’t forget, you can enter your own car in the Outlaw Pinewood Derby too), Boy Scouts can even start the Automotive Maintenance Merit Badge. There is even a patch design contest so bring your ideas of the patch you would like for next year. The choice is yours! There will also be a Dutch oven cook-off on Saturday, during dinner. So don’t forget to bring your favorite recipe and wow the judges!

The registration fee is \$15 per Scout and leader/parent. This fee includes a specially designed Thunder in the Hills patch, admission to the Saturday night race and trophies. **All fees must be submitted at the time of registration.**

If your troop/pack plans on attending, but have not registered by Friday, September 21, you MUST email Todd Swain (<mailto:tmanswain@yahoo.com>) with an estimated number of participants that you will be bringing, otherwise you may not be able to attend the Saturday night race.

ACTIVITIES

Outlaw Pinewood Derby:

“As long as it fits on the track,” anything goes race. There are three divisions: Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts and Adults.

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners from each division.

Trophies will also be awarded to the “Best of Show” for each division. The spectators for the Woodhull Race are the judges for the “Best of Show” awards.

Volleyball:

There will be a volleyball net available for friendly games.

Corn Hole:

There will be two sets of corn hole games available for friendly games.

Sack Races/3-Legged Races:

Sacks will be provided for a sack race (even adults can race!). Find a buddy to do a 3-legged race!

Candy bar bingo:

Please bring a candy bar for each game of bingo you want to participate in. There is a limit of one board per participant per game. The “winnings” will be giving to the winner of the game (split amongst winners if there is more than one).

Movie:

Friday night, weather permitting, there will be a scout appropriate movie in the big tent. Don't forget to bring your blanket or chair to sit on.

Automotive Maintenance Merit Badge:

You can start your Automotive Merit Badge at this event. Please bring your own worksheets/merit badge book if you plan on starting this.
