General Rules

1. Every Unit must have 2 Deep Leadership at any and all Scout Activities. The Scout Oath and Law will be our Guide for the event.
2. All Registration MUST be done ONLINE at the Five Rivers Council Website. Because we are providing lunch for all participants, we need an accurate count.
3. Deadline for registration is October 8th. Any unit not registered by this date not be allowed to register. NO EXCEPTIONS!!
4. Parking is allowed in parking areas ONLY. NO vehicles can be in the campsites. This includes Unit Trailers.
5. Units will be camping around the program field. NO camping on the program field.
6. NO ground fires are allowed at the facility. Units may bring raised fire pits, barrels, etc. AND all ashes are to be cleaned up after camporee.
7. This is a Carry In - Carry Out event so please remove any trash your unit generates during the event.
8. Park personnel have warned of Bears frequenting the area so please keep all trash and food properly stored and no food in tents, or left out on tables.
9. Saturday Lunch will be provided for all, so when planning your menu keep this in mind.
10. VERY IMPORTANT! Each patrol must bring with them 4 lawn mower type wheels. They do not need to match as we will be putting them in a pile for the scouts to select for their custom craft.
11. All other materials will be provided for the scouts to select as they see fit.
12. For the safety of the scouts a special wood fabricating tent, as well as a metal fabricating tent will be set up and run by staff members.
13. There will be a limited number of hand tools on hand for the scouts to use, as well as rope to lash projects together.
14. All projects will be done by the scouts in the Youth Only area. Adults will have their own area for their project. Any adults found in the youth area will result in their unit being disqualified. Staff members will be posted in the youth area for safety and compliance.
15. Please by all means remember to follow the Guide to Safe Scouting and always have 2 deep leadership.

Directions to Round Top

From Elmira: Take route 86 East to Exit 60. Follow route 220 South to Greens Landing, (You will see a Dandy on your Left) at The Dandy you will turn Right, Follow that road until you see Round Top Rd. Turn Right on Round Top Rd. and follow to Park.
