Outlaw Pinewood Derby:

“As long as it fits on the track,” *anything goes race*. There are three divisions: Cub Scouts, Scouts BSA/Venturing and Adults.

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners from each division.

Trophies will also be awarded to the “Best of Show” for each division. The spectators for the Woodhull Race are the judges for the “Best of Show” awards.

LEGO derby races:

Build your LEGO derby car and race it Friday night. This race is just for fun, no prizes.

Volleyball:

There will be a volleyball net available for friendly games.

Corn Hole:

There will be two sets of corn hole games available for friendly games.

Movie:

Friday night, weather permitting, there will be a scout appropriate movie in the big tent. Don't forget to bring your blanket or chair to sit on.

Dutch Oven Cook-off:

Bring your best recipe to make in your Dutch oven. Breakfast, lunch, dinner or dessert, whatever you want to make!
